



## H.R.S.T.A is proud to announce our **6th Annual 2023 CPR Derby**










## May 1st — August 31st, 2023

- There are **4 monthly** species prizes, along with grand prizes for the coveted "**FISH HAWK** Angler of the Year", Runner Up and 2nd Runner Up
- Monthly species prizes awarded to 1st, 2nd & 3rd place for longest length in inches for each species.
- Our **RAPALA** JUNIOR division for ages up to and including 16 years old. Juniors will compete for the Junior championship, but will also compete in the Open division for the coveted "**FISH HAWK** Angler of the Year".

**Note:** a participant can continually upgrade the length of any specific species throughout the four (4) month,123 day competition. The monthly winners will be determined by the longest fish at **midnight**, on the last day of each "Species" month.

For example, the largest Coho (June), will be determined at midnight June 30th, so the angler has 61 days to catch the longest Coho. Once the Coho has been crowned as the monthly winner at midnight on June 30th.

\*\*The angler can "cull" that fish and continually upgrade the length towards the Angler of the Year total length.\*\*
